RESOLUTION NO. 008 OF THE YEAR 2000

At the regular monthly meeting for the Town of Harpersfield on October 2, 2000, Councilman Harold Bedford offered the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

TITLE: An Agreement To Support The Application To The Department Of State For Master Planning And Zoning Incentive Awards.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to develop/update the Town of Harpersfield's Comprehensive Plan and determine the current needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, the New York Department of State has grant moneys available in the amount of \$10,000.00 for Comprehensive Plan development as part of the New York Master Plan and Zoning Incentive Awards Program to update community comprehensive plans and zoning laws within the New York City Watershed; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Harpersfield is currently experiencing local changes and has shown a need to address community growth issues; and

WHEREAS, other available grant moneys may be contingent on meeting local and regional goals as established by Comprehensive Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Harpersfield Board would like to apply for a grant in the amount of \$10,000.00 to hire a qualified consultant to update the Town Comprehensive Plan to reflect the current changes in the community and the desires of the Town residents; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Harpersfield Board approves the application to the Department of State for a grant in the amount of \$10,000.00 to develop/update the Town of Harpersfield Comprehensive Plan.
