RESOLUTION NUMBER 006 OF 2000

Norma Voegel offered the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

TITLE: A Resolution For Delaware Opportunities Inc. To Engage Direct Employees To Perform Some Of The Remaining Housing Rehabilitation Work In The CDBG Program.

WHEREAS, the Town of Harpersfield has accepted Delaware Opportunities Inc. to administer the housing rehabilitation program grant funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under the CDBG Small Cities Program; and

WHEREAS, Delaware Opportunities Inc. has notified James Eisel Sr., Town Supervisor by letter that the program has come to a virtual stand still due to a lack of bidders; and

WHEREAS, Delaware Opportunities in hopes of moving this program forward has proposed hiring a three person crew in the following situations:

- A) There is no responsible bidder.
- B) The selected bidder fails to initiate the job within 60 days from the notice to proceed.
- C) The crew has no available work and can complete the work at or below cost presented by the lowest responsible bidder.

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on August 7, 2000 and anyone wishing to be heard has been given a chance to speak on this issue;

NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Harpersfield Town Board formally request this change in the CDBG program from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
