RESOLUTION NO. 005 OF THE YEAR 2013.

Councilman Robert Reeve Jr. offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Western Catskills Community Revitalization Council, Inc. is applying for two grants under the NYS Consolidation Funding Application for funds to develop and plan the upgrade and redesign of the Headwater Trails which are in part in the Town of Harpersfield.

WHEREAS, applications will be submitted to:

the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP) Park Acquisition, Development and Planning Program; and

the Environmental Protection Fund Recreational Trails Program which is managed by the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation.

WHEREAS, the Headwaters Trail project which is located in the Towns of Harpersfield and Stamford in Delaware County and the Towns of Jefferson and Gilboa in Schoharie County, as part of the site located within the territorial jurisdiction of this Board; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement under the rules of these programs, said not-for-profit corporation must obtain the "approval/endorsement of the governing body of the municipality in which the project will be located".

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by this august body that the Board of the Town of Harpersfield hereby does approve and endorse the application of the Western Catskills Community Revitalization Council, Inc. for a grant under the Environmental Protection Fund for the Recreational Trails Program and a grant under the NYS Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation for the trail project known as Headwaters Trails and located in part within this community.
