RESOLUTION NO. 004 OF THE YEAR 2008

At the regular meeting of the Town of Harpersfield held on April 8, 2008, Councilman Harold Bedford offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

TITLE: AGREEMENT TO SUPPORT APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE FOR WATER QUALITY PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION GRANTS FOR COMMUNITIES IN THE NYC WATERSHED PROGRAM MONEYS FOR THE ODELL LAKE ROAD EXTENSION STORMWATER REMEDIATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Town of Harpersfield has identified portions of the Odell Lake Road Extension stormwater infrastructure that suffer from excessive erosion due to the speed of stormwater runoff; and

WHEREAS, the New York Department of State has grant moneys available for the implementation of water quality enhancement projects within the New York City Watershed; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Harpersfield Highway Department has developed a proposal for the remediation of stormwater infrastructure on Odell Lake Road Extension, located within the NYC Watershed; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Harpersfield would like to apply for a grant in the amount of \$25,000.00 to fund the purchase of materials required for the installation of stormwater control measures in an effort to reduce erosion of stormwater infrastructure on Odell Lake Road Extension and the turbidity of runoff into Lake Brook.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Harpersfield Town Board approves the application to the Department of State for a grant to fund the Odell Lake Road Extension stormwater remediation project.
