RESOLUTION NUMBER 005 OF 2000

At the regular monthly meeting for the Town of Harpersfield on June 5, 2000, Harold Bedford offered the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

TITLE: A Resolution Placing A Moratorium On The Construction Of Cell Towers In The Town Of Harpersfield.

WHEREAS, Dean Darling, Chairman of the Planning Board for the Town of Harpersfield had come before the Town Board with valid concerns about the construction of cell towers; and


WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes the Town Planning Board will need time to prepare an Ordinance dealing with the concerns of construction and responsibility of Cell Tower owners; and

WHEREAS, the Town Planning Board will need to present the Ordinance to the Town Board for a Public Hearing and Board approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Harpersfield Board agrees to place a 120 (one hundred twenty) day moratorium on the construction of Cell Towers in the Town of Harpersfield.
