RESOLUTION NO. 007 OF THE YEAR 2012

Councilman Robert Reeve Jr. offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

TITLE: RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HARPERSFIELD DETERMINING THAT THERE ARE NO ADVERSE IMPACTS ON THE ENVIRONMENT FROM ADOPTION OF THE FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION LAW.

WHEREAS, the Town Board is adopting a local law that repeals and supersedes Local Law No. 1 of the year 1987 entitled "Flood Damage Prevention Law" in order to maintain the community's eligibility to participate in the National Flood Insurance Program ("NFIP");


WHEREAS, the possible environmental impacts of the adoption of the Law have been considered by the Town Board;
