RESOLUTION NO. 004 OF THE YEAR 2005

At the meeting of the Town of Harpersfield held on March 7, 2005, Councilman David Ogborn offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Conservation of the State of New York is responsible for the protection of the water resources of certain classified waters in New York State as set forth in Part III-A of Article V of the Conservation law; and

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Environmental Conservation of the State of New York and the Town of Harpersfield established an agreement of cooperation between the parties hereinafter mentioned for the administration of this responsibility.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Philip E. Simmons, Highway Superintendent is hereby empowered to sign the attached Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the Town of Harpersfield; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Memorandum of Understanding shall take effect immediately upon its acceptance by the Department of Environmental Conservation.
